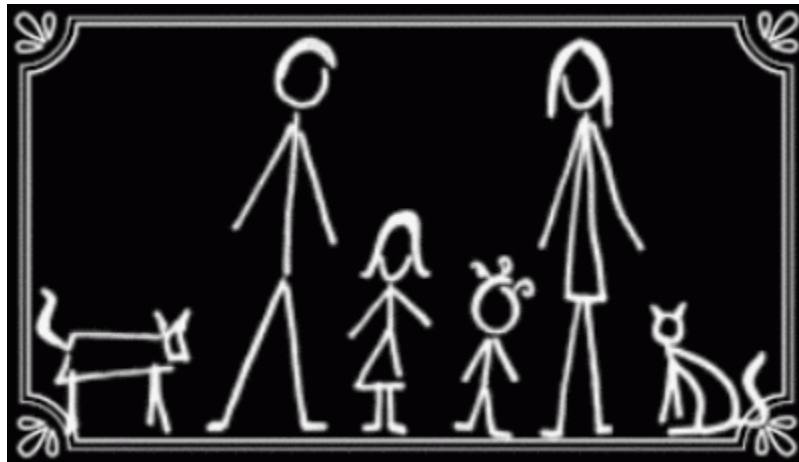

As Teacher & Staff Appreciation Week comes to a close, my gratitude doesn't end here.

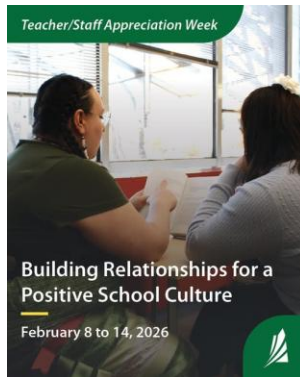
Every day, we deeply appreciate the teachers and school staff in Saskatoon for the meaningful contributions you make to support the learning success

TOUR AND MEETING AT BRIARCREST COLLEGE

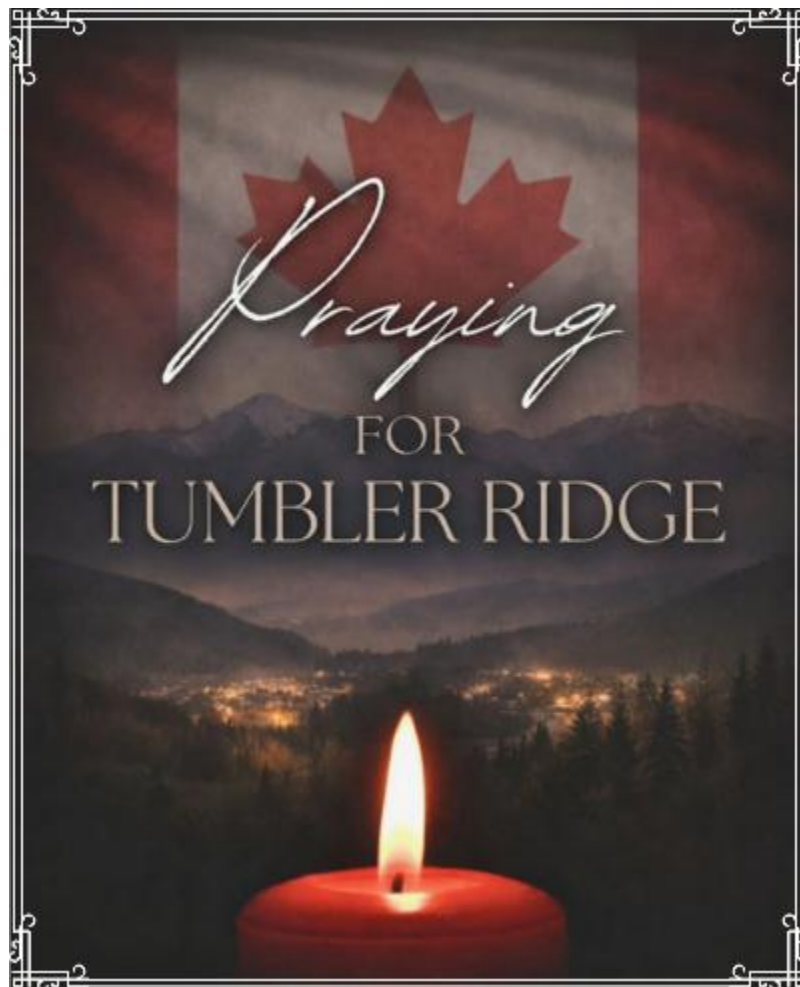

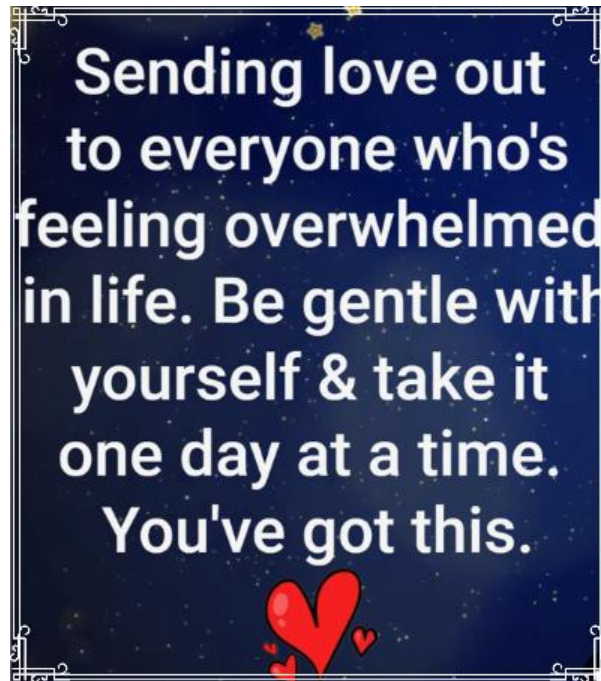

**ROBOT ASSISTED SURGERIES STRENGTHENING PATIENT CARE IN
SASKATCHEWAN**



Saskatchewan patients are benefiting from a newly added robot-assisted surgical (RAS) system located at the Royal University Hospital (RUH) in Saskatoon.

This is now the fourth robotic system operating in Saskatchewan - one of the highest per capita of any Canadian province. Two other systems are located at St. Paul's Hospital in Saskatoon and another was introduced to the Pasqua Hospital in Regina last fall.

"With the continued expansion of our robot-assisted surgical program, more patients will have access to minimally invasive surgical procedures that result in quicker recoveries close to home," Health Minister Jeremy Cockrill said. "I want to extend a sincere thank you to our surgeons and health care

teams for continuing to work together to help expand surgical access in our province.”

A few fun facts about Valentine's Day:

- In order of popularity, Valentine's Day cards are given to teachers, children, mothers, wives, sweethearts and pets.
- On Valentine`s Day every year, there are at least 36 million heart shape boxes of chocolates sold.
- The red rose was the favourite flower of Venus, the Roman goddess of love.
- Worldwide, over 50 million roses are given for Valentine's Day each year.
- In the Middle Ages, young men and women drew names from a bowl to see who would be their Valentine. They would wear this name pinned onto their sleeves for one week for everyone to see. That was the origin of the expression "to wear your heart on your sleeve."

- **Richard Cadbury invented the first Valentine's Day candy box in the late 1800s.**
- **Probably the first greeting cards, handmade valentines, appeared in the 16th century. As early as 1800, companies began mass-producing cards. Initially, these cards were hand-colored by factory workers. By the early 20th century even fancy lace and ribbon-strewn cards were created by machines.**

February 8-14



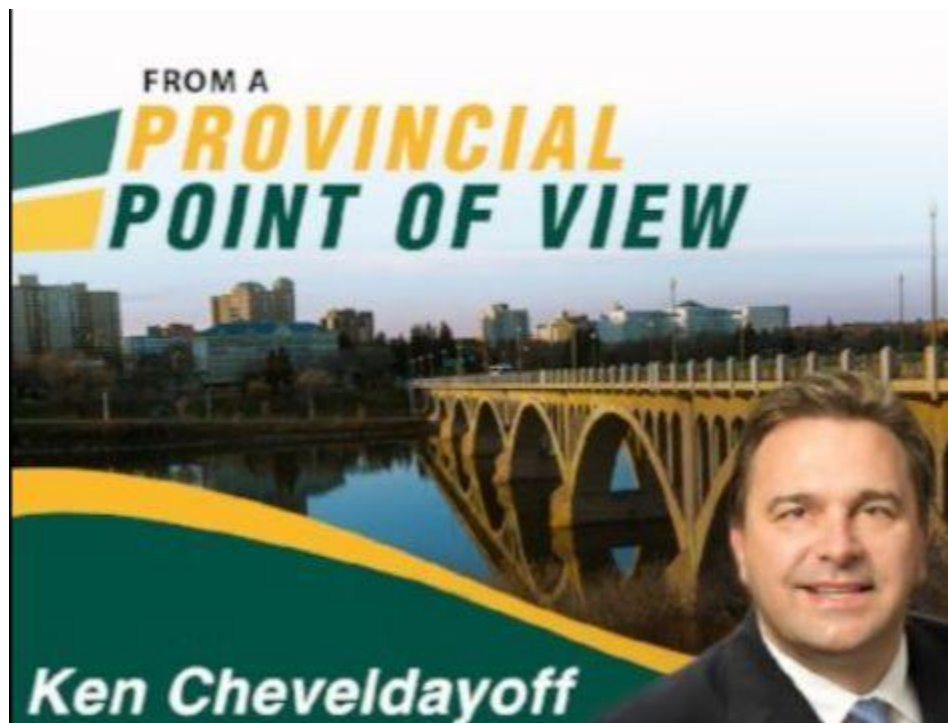

"Talking openly with a trusted health care provider about sexual and reproductive health is an important step in maintaining your overall wellbeing," Mental Health and Addictions, Seniors and Rural and Remote Health Minister Lori Carr said. "When people feel comfortable asking

questions, it helps reduce stigma, support prevention, early diagnosis and treatment, and contributes to stronger, healthier communities."
