

Second stage housing supports



Additional \$108,000 over three years to address interpersonal violence and abuse



We have committed \$108,000 over three years to provide additional funding for second-stage housing in Prince Albert and Regina.

This funding is in addition to the \$876,000 that was committed in the 2022–23 budget for five second-stage housing facilities in Saskatchewan, bringing this year's total investment for seven facilities to \$984,000.

Second-stage housing offers safe, long-term, affordable housing for women and their children, who are victims of interpersonal violence and abuse.

Here, clients are linked to education and employment opportunities, counselling, and programming supports for children, helping them to heal and live a life that is free from violence and abuse


